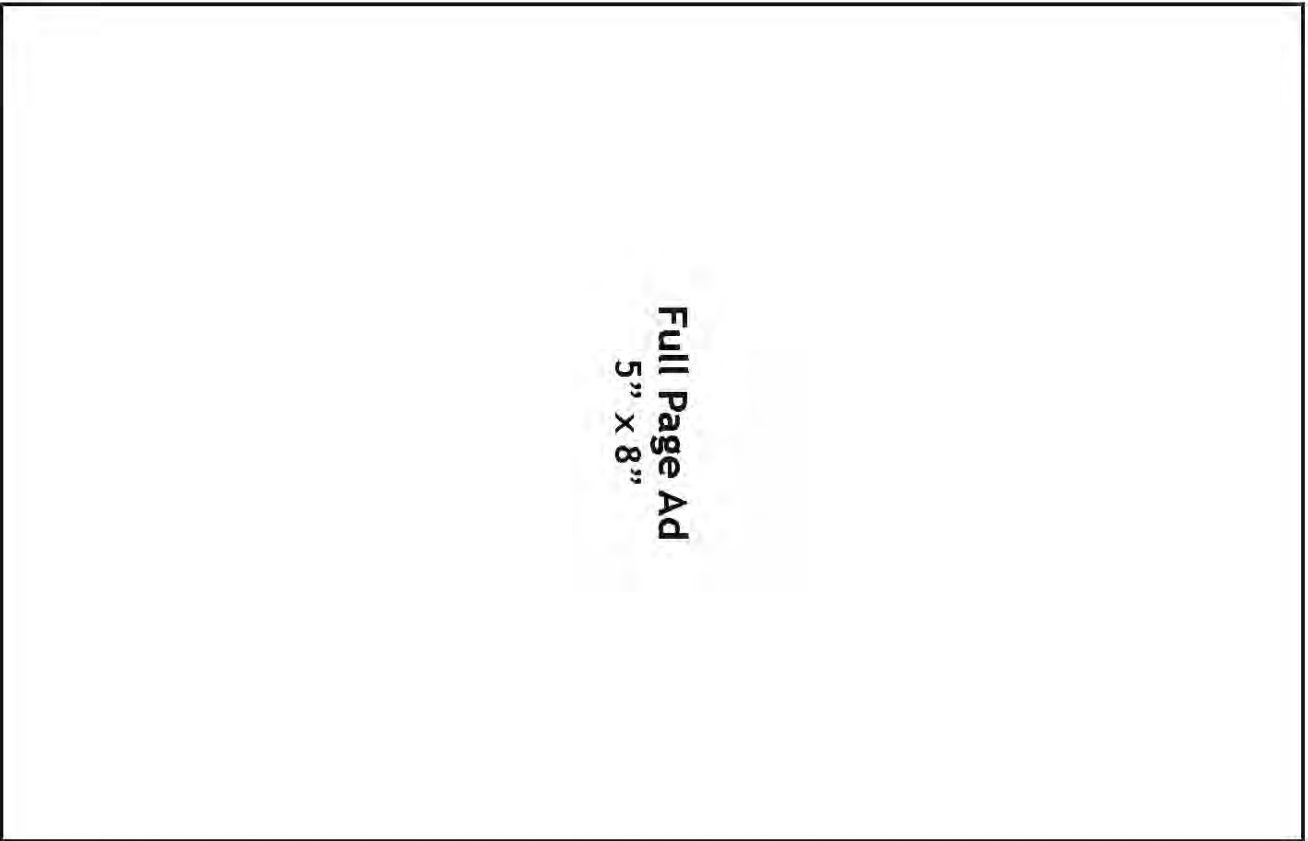

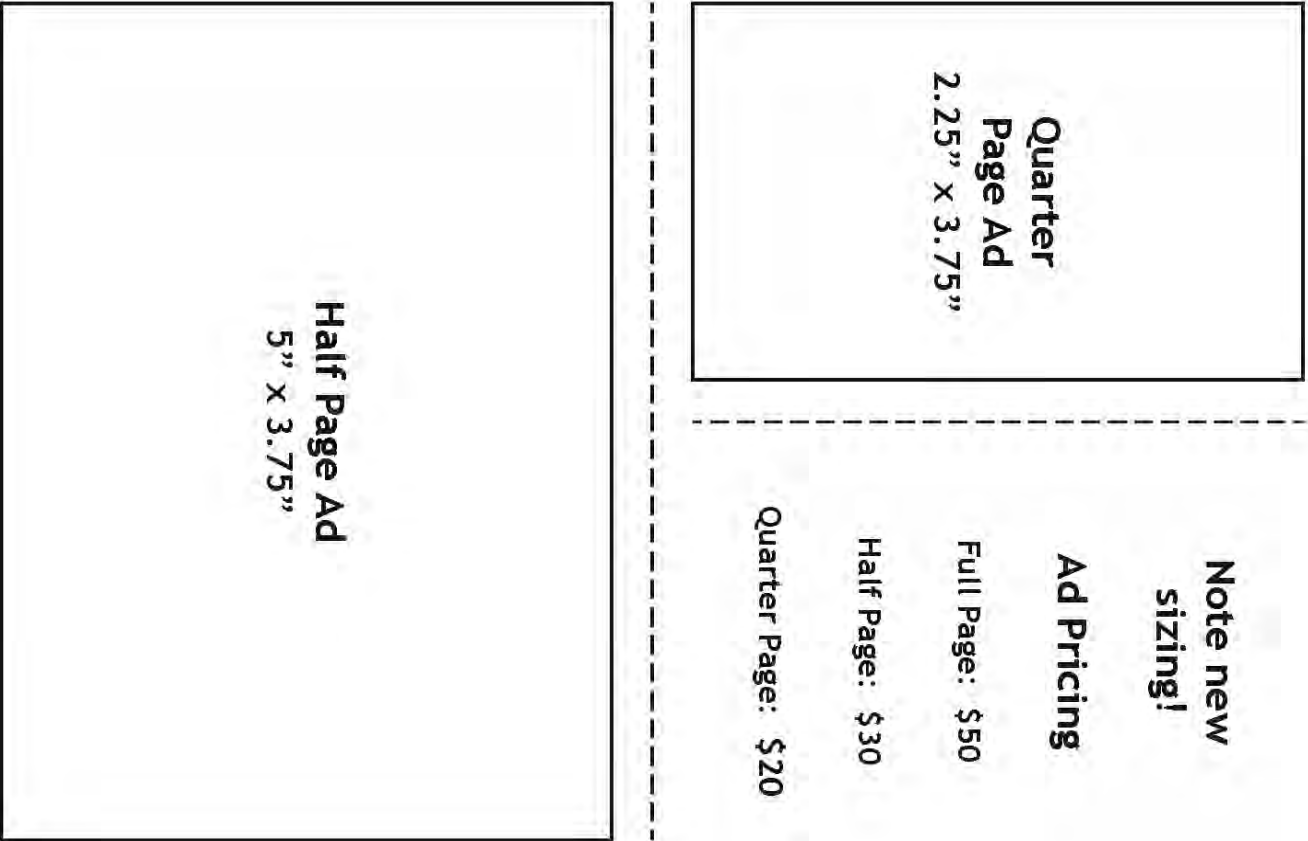

## Grand Ball Lodging for November 18, 2024: [Options for Lodging](#)

- Park your own trailer: If you have a trailer/camper and wish to use it overnight, we have gotten permission to “dry camp” overnight at the Eugene Lodge where Willamette Court Meets. This will be the location of the Group meetings and Grand Court Holiday Party on November 19, 2024. You will want to park the trailer at the lodge before proceeding to the Grand Ball at the Moose Lodge in Springfield. **Please contact K Lee Horn if you plan to park a camper / trailer at the lodge.** We will need to know if we need someone on-site to manage the trailer parking. Additionally, we can give you information on what part of the parking area to place the camper/trailer. Be sure to lock up your cars/trailers, and don’t leave valuables in sight.


