



Grand Ball Lodging for November 18, 2024: Options for Lodging

- Park your own trailer: If you have a trailer/camper and wish to use it overnight, we have gotten permission to "dry camp" overnight at the Eugene Lodge where Willamette Court Meets. This will be the location of the Group meetings and Grand Court Holiday Party on November 19, 2024. You will want to park the trailer at the lodge before proceeding to the Grand Ball at the Moose Lodge in Springfield. Please contact K Lee Horn if you plan to park a camper / trailer at the lodge.
