Grand Court is near - below are some reminders for all.

Please inquire if you have any additional questions. We are looking forward to our "Joy of The Journey" Session of Oregon Grand Court

1. Packing List:

- a. Remember your 2024 Dues Card!
- b. Name badge wallets please bring them if you have one.
- c. HL's bring your gloves. Please wear full-fingered white gloves for Necrology and Memorial on Friday afternoon.
- d. Royal Matrons bring your crown. If you are unable to attend, please ask someone to fill in your position for the Necrology Ceremony. RM dress for all sessions (unless a Grand Officer). White dress for Memorial.
- e. Royal Patrons bring your sword. You will need your sword for the Necrology Ceremony and the floral arch for the retiring march of the Grand Officers following the Uncrowning Ceremony. Red vests for regular sessions (unless a Grand Officer).

2. Before Opening on Thursday afternoon:

- a. Register first HL Trysta, Registration Chairman and her team will be eager to register all.
- b. If entitled to vote please see the Credentials Committee.
 - i. Sign your ballots and your voting card.
 - ii. Remember to bring your "Voting Card" to all Friday and Saturday sessions. You will need your ballot on Saturday morning for elections.
- c. Be on time for all Grand Court practices listed in the session book.

3. Grand Court meetings:

- a. Upon entering the Grand Court room, show your dues card, give the grip and password to the Grand Sentinel <u>and</u> Grand Warder.
- b. Leaving the Grand Court room while in session be sure to take your dues card to re-enter the Grand Court room.
- c. When entering or leaving the Grand Court room march one step West of the Square, salute with the Secret Sign of Salutation, then march to the door or be seated. Items may be carried with you, keeping your left arm free.
- d. If you wish to speak advance to a microphone salute pause to be recognized by the presiding officer, then state your name and court then say, "I move that...." "Or I move to....". Please do not state "I make a motion....". You should be prepared to provide the motion or amendment to a motion, written out for the Grand Royal Matron and Grand Secretary before you stand to be recognized.
